"We're Waiting" is a powerful and unifying message for one of the most important legal and social reforms of our time.

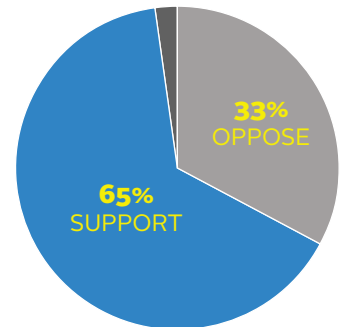
While we wait, we will do everything we can to keep our message of equality before the broadest possible audience and win the 25 additional MPs' votes required to make marriage equality a reality.

#### DO SOMETHING

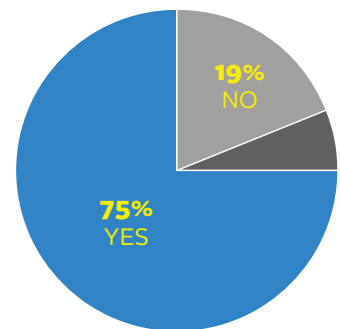
There are a variety of ways you can get involved, help make history and show your support for marriage equality.

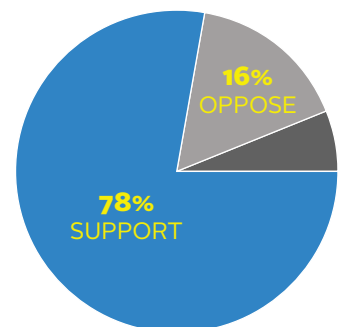

#### DID YOU KNOW...

**73%** of Labor, **52%** of Coalition and **87%** of Green voters support marriage\*

**81%** of Coalition voters support a Coalition conscience vote on marriage equality\*

**72%** of Australians with young children support marriage equality†

**53%** of Australians who identify as Christians support marriage equality\*\*

**59%** of blue collar workers support equality, only 5% lower than the national average\*

**59%** of rural and regional dwellers support marriage equality, only 5 points less than those in capital cities^^
