

# 1. Methodology



# Methodology

- ▶ This study was conducted on the Galaxy Telephone Omnibus on the weekend of 10-12 February 2012.
- ▶ The sample was 786 Australians aged 18-64 years, distributed throughout Australia, as follows:

➤ NSW/ACT	228
➤ Victoria/Tasmania	220
➤ Queensland	147
➤ South Australia	90
➤ Western Australia	101
- ▶ Age, gender and region quotas were applied to the sample.
- ▶ Following the completion of interviewing, the data was weighted by age, gender and region to reflect the latest ABS population estimates.



## 2. Main Findings



# Main Findings

## **Agreement/Disagreement that same-sex couple should be allowed to marry (QC1)**

- ▶ Overall 62% of Australians believe that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry. Overall, one quarter (29%) strongly agree and 33% (just) agree.
- ▶ Support of same-sex marriage is stronger in the younger age groups with 81% of 18-24 year olds supporting same-sex marriage compared to 51% of 50-64 years supporting same-sex marriage.

## **Willingness to support same-sex marriage if churches were guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples (QC2)**

- ▶ Overall, 28% of Australians are ‘more willing’ to support that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry if churches were guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples and 17% are ‘less willing’ to support that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry (53% say that it would make no difference). On balance, 11% overall are more willing to support that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry.
- ▶ Generally younger ages are more willing to support that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry if churches were guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples with 48% of 18-24 year olds being ‘more willing’ and 4% being ‘less willing’, compared to 24% of 50-64 year olds being ‘more willing’ and 26% being ‘less willing’ to support same-sex marriage.



# Main Findings

## The impact of the statement guaranteeing churches right of refusal on agreement/disagreement that same-sex couple should be allowed to marry (QC1 by QC2)

- ▶ Among Australians who (just/somewhat) **disagree** that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry 16% are 'more willing' to support SS-M if churches were guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples, while 32% are 'less likely'.
- ▶ Among Australians who (just/somewhat) **agree** that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry 32% are 'more willing' to support SS-M if churches were guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples, while 10% are 'less likely'.
- ▶ This indicates that the fact that churches would be guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples is polarising in that people who (just) disagree with supporting SS-M are less willing to support SS-M with the additional statement, and those who (just) agree with SS-M are more willing to support SS-M with the additional statement.
- ▶ Overall, 2% of people say that they (just/somewhat) **disagree** that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry but are 'more willing' to support SS-M if churches were guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples. 4% of 18-24 year olds say this.
- ▶ Overall, 10% of people say that they (just/somewhat) **agree** that same-sex couples should be allowed to marry but are 'more willing' to support SS-M if churches were guaranteed the right to refuse to marry same-sex couples. 15% of 18-24 year olds say this. This indicates that the additional statement has relatively greater support among younger people.

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# Tables

## 1 BASE: Weight Sample (000's):

The number of completed interviews has been weighted to reflect the latest ABS population estimates. These estimates are shown in thousands (000's). The percentages in the table are based on these weighted figures.

## 2 WEIGHTS:

This indicates that in order to reflect the latest ABS population estimates the data has been weighted by age, gender and area.

## 3 FILTERS (Where applicable):

If the table is based on a subset of respondents then this will be titled as a Filter and accompanied by a description of the sample upon which the table is based.

## 4 RESPONDENTS:

These figures show the actual sample size, indicating the total number of respondents who were asked the relevant question.
